



## **EXPERIENCE THE SUPERNATURAL** **Bible Reading Plan by Paula Gilbert**

▪**OVERVIEW:** The supernatural is a prevalent reality throughout the entire Holy Bible, and did not pass away after the time of the first apostles. Jesus Christ (the Alpha and Omega, the Beginning and the End), is the same yesterday, today, and forever. God tells us in His Word that He changes not. As sons and daughters of the Most High God, we can expect the unexpected. Afterall, we have a supernatural God who delights in giving us His

kingdom; we are heirs of His great treasures (Romans 8: 17). Jesus said His kingdom is not of this world. Neither are we of this world; we are strangers and pilgrims passing through. Scripture also informs us that the kingdom of God - His kingdom - is within us. We are the temple, and we are carriers of His presence! The God of Wonders dwells within us through the baptism of the Holy Spirit. How can we settle for anything less than the supernatural? It is our birthright!

▪**OBJECTIVE:** This bible reading plan contains scriptures relating to the supernatural power of God and the spiritual realm, so the believer can reflect on these passages, and thus be moved to a deeper place of revelation and divine purpose through contemplation of heavenly things. This plan does not include every book and chapter of the Bible, and it is not in chronological or numerical order. Some passages are longer; others are very short, but each one has been carefully selected to demonstrate not only miraculous events that can still occur today, but also the believer's inherited power, position, and authority for spiritual breakthrough and heavenly encounters.

▪**SUGGESTED METHOD:** Read these verses

**slowly and meditate on them. The intent of this plan is to allow the Holy Spirit to illuminate these scriptures, and to let them penetrate your heart, so the Word becomes 'flesh' (believable, tangible, personal, experiential) rather than mere intellectual knowledge. Go at your own pace! Faith [for the supernatural] comes by hearing, and hearing by the Word.**
