Heb 8:12 For I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their iniquities will I remember no more.

Now, get a Bible and start reading it. King James is a good translation, because it is closest to the original Greek and Hebrew, but God can work through other versions, though they are not as pure.

Be Holy Spirit baptized (read: *Have You Received the Holy Spirit Since You Believed?* www.sinisachoice.com.) Be filled with God's power!

Find Holy Spirit filled Christian believers to fellowship with (Heb 10:25). **AVOID JEHOVAH'S WITNESSES, MORMONS, CHRISTIAN SCIENCE—THEY ARE CULTS!**

Be water baptized to show (symbolically) what has taken place inwardly when your conscience was cleansed from sin through the washing of water by the Word of God, and you rose from death into life (Eph 5:25,26/Rom 6:3-6).

Pray to God daily and spend time with Him. You are about to go on an *amazing* journey, so congratulations! Remember, it's not a cake walk, but endure to the end, and you will be saved! (Mark 13:13/Php 2:12)

2Pe 2:20 For if after they have escaped the pollutions of the world through the knowledge of the Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, they are again entangled therein, and overcome, the latter end is worse with them than the beginning.

2Pe 2:21 For it had been better for them not to have known the way of righteousness, than, after they have known it, to turn from the holy commandment delivered unto them.

You Must Be Born Again

Why? Because Jesus Christ said so:

Joh 3:7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.

Joh 3:3 Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.

What does it mean to be born again? Can you enter in to your mother's womb and be born once more?

Joh 3:4 Nicodemus saith unto him, How can a man be born when he is old? can he enter the second time into his mother's womb, and be born?

Joh 3:5 Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.

Joh 3:6 That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.

To be born again means to be *new* in spirit—to be spiritually *regenerated*, or made ALIVE once more.

But why? I haven't died!

You haven't died physically, but *spiritually*, you are dead in sin, because the Bible says that the wages of sin is death, and ALL have sinned, so all have died.

Rom 6:23 For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Rom 5:12 Wherefore, as by one man {Adam} sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned.

Rom 3:23 For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God.

When Adam sinned, sin entered the environment (the world). All selfishly chose to sin (transgress the Law), and face the penalty of Hell. All chose to break the commandments of God:

Thou shalt have no other gods before me

Thou shalt make no graven images (to worship)

Thou shalt not take the name of the Lord in vain

Remember the Sabbath, to keep it holy
Thou shalt honor thy father and thy mother
Thou shalt not kill
Thou shalt not commit adultery
Thou shalt not steal
Thou shalt not bear false witness (lie)
Thou shalt not covet

God sent His only begotten Son to pay the price for our sins (blood for blood, life for life, because the life of mankind is in the blood).

Jesus Christ's blood atonement removes the sin from man's conscience, making his heart pure. He is spiritually regenerated, and no longer dead in sins. He is alive again in Christ. He is born again through the Word (Jesus Christ *is* the Word: John 1) of the gospel.

1Pe 1:23 Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever.

If you'll admit that you are a sinner, repent of your sins, and believe that Jesus Christ is God's anointed Son who died for you, you can become **SAVED** from Hell (born again):

Rom 10:9 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.

Rom 10:10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

1Jn 5:1 Whosoever believeth that Jesus is the Christ is born of God: and every one that loveth him that begat loveth him also that is begotten of him.

1Jn 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Important! This is not an "easy believism" where you confess Jesus with your mouth and then you're *good to go* for life, regardless of whether you continue in your sin or not.

Oh no! Count the cost, because the devils also believe in God, but they're not going to Heaven (Jas 2:19)! You must take up your cross and follow Jesus.

You must die to self, and live for God. Do His will, keep his commandments, and be led by His Spirit rather than your old fleshly desires when you were unregenerate. You can't look back on your old life and continue in sin. Oh no! You must come clean of it and have a change of heart/change of mind.

Luk 9:62 And Jesus said unto him, No man, having put his hand to the plough, and looking back, is fit for the kingdom of God.

Mar 8:34 And when he had called the people unto him with his disciples also, he said unto them, Whosoever will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow me.

Mar 8:35 For whosoever will save his life shall lose it; but whosoever shall lose his life for my sake and the gospel's, the same shall save it.

We are saved by grace through faith, not of works (Eph 2:8,9). But the Bible also tells us that faith without works is dead, being alone (Jas 2:17). So we come to God in faith, and because of His grace and not our own accomplishments, we will be saved. Then, this salvation will produce good works in our lives as God sanctifies and purges us through the power of His Holy Spirit. Come as you are, in true repentance. Let Him help you overcome sin!

Say this simple heartfelt prayer:

Lord, I am a sinner. I am sorry for ALL of my sins. I ask for your forgiveness for them all. I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God, who died and rose again for my sins. I ask Jesus into my heart, to become LORD and SAVIOR of my life. In Jesus' Mighty Name, amen.

Now, by faith, you are a new creature in Christ. You are born again!

2Co 5:17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

2Co 5:18 And all things are of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ.

God remembers your sins no more, so
